## Introduction

## Learning Overview

In maths, we will be counting in 2s, 3s and 4s and solve problems around wheels and vehicles. We will also find out about clocks and start learning to tell the time. As scientists we will learn about forces and test different height ramps and surfaces for our Formula 1 cars. In Expressive, Arts and Design we will look at illustration art, colour wheels and the artist Wassily Kandinsky. We will make vehicles with moving parts. In PE we will use Real PE and Real Gym to explore games and gymnastics.
