Dear Parents/Carers

Re: Uniform Consultation



We are seeking the views of parents to the proposed change of uniform (as in the photograph above).

The proposal is that the gold polo shirt will be replaced by a white shirt and tie. The school jumper with the logo and all other aspects of the uniform will remain the same.

The proposed uniform change is designed to be smarter and be more up to date. Further advantages are that replacing white shirts is a cheaper option than buying new gold polo shirts. We have been repeatedly informed that the gold polo shirts do not wash well and can soon lose their colour.

The planned change to the uniform would take place this September, at the start of the new academic year 2018/19. **The change would only apply to Years 5 and 6 next year** (due to contractual obligations with our current supplier). All other year groups will follow in academic year 2019/20. Years 5 and 6 children in the Woodlands Unit will continue to wear the gold polo shirts.

Parents will have a choice of conventional, clip-on or elasticated ties for their child. This most likely will be determined by the age of your child.

In the summer, children will be allowed to wear the gingham dress as they do at present.

The children in Year 5 have responded favourably to the proposed change when they were shown the uniform.
