

Introduction

Children will come back to school and be introduced to a variety of different fruits. They will use these fruits as a basis for observational drawings. After this children will use their senses to describe the fruit before getting to eat them and make them out of marzipan. .

Later on children will be introduced to Fair trade. Children will visit a local supermarket to find and compare Fairtrade products to non-Fairtrade products. After this children will use their map reading skills to locate Fairtrade countries on a world map.

To conclude the theme parents will be invited to come in to our 'Fairtrade Extravaganza ' .



Learning overview:

Using Jamaican culture as an inspiration, children will write their own Anansi stories. They will also look at writing biographies about famous Jamaicans. As scientists, children will be looking at healthy food and teeth. They will explore the different food groups and how to look after their teeth. As geographers children will locate countries on a world map and study physical and human aspects of nature. During our art lessons, children will create a collage of fruit using oil pastels. As computer scientists we will be looking at debugging computer programs to solve problems and as Mathematicians we will look be looking at Geometry.
